
Membership

Background

EIRG is an association registered in Sweden which is run by its members. This protocol outlines the process and benefits for becoming a member. Please reference articles 5, 6, 14 and 18 in the association's articles.

Application Process

Interested persons (not legal entities) can become members. They will be asked to complete the following procedure:

- Read and agree to terms of EIRG association membership
- Agree to comply to EIRG protocols
- Submit information to be used for a member profile
- Pay membership fee

Other than the website, an individual can state their interest to become a member through email to info@eirg.org.

Memberships must be renewed after each annual meeting. If they are not paid then a reminder email will be sent after two weeks and then again after four weeks. Members who have not paid will be removed from the register after six weeks from the annual meeting.

Responsibilities and Duties

Members of EIRG make a full commitment to attend the EIRG Annual Meeting in May each year. As an international organisation working between the EU and Iran, members must be prepared to travel between the regions as necessary. EIRG will not compensate any members for their participation costs unless they are sponsored by partner organisations.

Members are individuals who aim to take an active role within the association and should be able to clearly identify how they are contributing to EIRG's mission. Otherwise, we encourage the individual to join the wider network of EIRG.

Members must:

- Be ready to be called upon by the Board of Directors to assist with tasks.

- Take an active role in facilitating meetings and activities for members locally.
- Promote and actively attend EIRG events and activities.
- Agree to comply to the protocols of the association

Members are often individuals who are producing and sharing information/research on Iran within Europe. They can also be individuals who are managing cooperation between the EU and Iran.

Benefits

As a member you get:

- Access to the EIRG member community (database).
- Voting rights at EIRG Annual Meeting.
- Can be elected to the EIRG Board of Directors.
- Invitations to member only events and programs.
- Can participate in grant-funded research projects.

A member has no right to any of the assets of EIRG nor is a member liable for any of the liabilities of the association.

EIRG will follow the Swedish law called Personuppgiftslagen (Personal Data Act) for all members in the association.
